MONDAY, JULY 19th, 1937.

The Board of County Commissioners met in regular session on Monday, July 19th, 1937, at the hour of 10:00 o'clock A.M., with all members present: John H. Miller, Chairman; J. B. Gray and Harry L. Hopkins, members. Andy Stokes, County Clerk.

Chairman Miller presiding, the following business was transacted.

Reading of the minutes of the previous meeting was dispensed with and there being no objection to the same they were ordered to stand approved.

Motion by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner Hopkins, that the following Contract, be and the same is hereby entered into. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

CONTRACT FOR THE EXTERMINATION OF CERTAIN INSECTS.

THIS AGREEMENT, between C. I. Ragan & Company, of Tulsa, Oklahoma City, and Kansas City, Missouri, first party and Board of County Commissioners of the City of Tulsa, State of Oklahoma second party.

WITNESSETH:

FIRST: The first party hereby agrees to furnish its service for and during the period of One Year from the date hereof, to the second party under the following terms and conditions, to-wit:

1. The service to be rendered for the purpose of exterminating in the building, known as Poor Farm located on Broken Arrow Road. .
2. The first party agrees to keep said building substantially free and rid of bugs, insects during the list of the contract.

SECOND: In consideration of the above service, the second party agrees to pay the first party, the sum of \$300.00 payable as follows \$100.00 within thirty days & \$100.00 in four months and \$100.00 in eight months from date of contract.

Entered into this the 19 day of month of July, 1937.

It is further agreed that the party of the first part agrees to have exterminator inspect said premises from time to time, and subject to telephone calls without additional charge.
