RESOLUTION BY BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF TULSA COUNTY.

WHEREAS, a petition having been filed before this Board by the County Engineer of Tulsa County, asking that the County Surveyor of this County be directed to jointly serve with the County Surveyor of Osage County in making a survey to officially re-establish the line between Tulsa and Osage County, beginning at the corner of The Osage-Cherokee and Creek Nations; to be more specifically described beginning at the Southeast corner of Osage County, the same being on the Westerly limits of Tulsa, and re-establishing the said line Westerly to the line between Sections Five (5) and Six (6) Township Nineteen (19) North, Range Twelve (12) East, Tulsa County and,

WHEREAS, said petition set s out that the original Government corners have been destroyed and that conflicting surveys have been made, and

WHEREAS, said petition further recites that in order to definitely establish the County Highway along such line that an official survey should be made by the respective Countys of Tulsa and Osage.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That the County Surveyor of this County be directed to confer with the County Engineer of Osage County, and that they arrange a date between them on which they may agree for the beginning of the said survey; that they definitely and officially establish the said line, setting permanent monuments on the restoration of the original Government land corners, properly and thoroughly witnessing the same, and that a transcript and plat of the notes and survey be filed in the office of the County Clerk of the respective Counties of Osage and Tulsa.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the County Clerk be directed that upon receipt of a resolution similar in form to this passed by the County of Osage, that he furnish a copy of the same to the County Surveyor of this County, which will be his authority to arrange with the County Surveyor of Osage County for the making of said survey, and that the expense of making the said survey shall be borne equally between the Counties of Tulsa and Osage.
