O R D E R

NOW, On this the 21st. day of April, 1930, the matter of the petition of J R DOOLITTLE for permission to lay a pipe line underneath certain highways in said County and State came up before the Board of County Commissioners of said County for hearing, and it appearing to the Board and each of the Commissioners thereof that it was just that the said J R DOOLITTLE be permitted ot use as much of the highway as designated by the description and petition foregoing, which description is as follows, tow-ti:

"Beginning at a point approximately Six Hundred and Sixty (660') feet South of the Northwest corner of Sectlion One (1) Township Eighteen (18) North, Range Fourteen (14), East, said point being on the east right of way line of County road; thence across the C,unty Road, running underneath the pavement with a one (1") inch pipe line, to a connection with a north and south main line of the Oklahoma Natural Gas Corporation".

AND, it further speparing from the petition herein that said pipe line will be soconstructed as not to interfere with any of the rights of the general public in the use of said highway; and will be constructed in accordance with all rules of the C,unty Commissioners and the laws of the State of Oklahoma governing same.

NOW, On this the 21st. day of April, 1930, the matter of the Petition of W M WILSON for permission to lay a pipe line under certain highways in said County and State, came up before the Board of C,unty Commissioners of said County for hearing, and it appearing to the Board and each of the Commissioners thereof that it was just that the said W M WILSON be permitted touse as much of the highway as designated by the description and petition foregoing, whish description is as follows:
