MONDAY, OCTOBER 10th, 1938.

Pursuant to recess heretofore taken, the Board of County Commissioners re-convened at the hour of 10:30 o'clock A.M., with all members present: John H. Miller, Chairman; J. B. Gray and Harry L. Hopkins, members. Andy Stokes, County Clerk.

John H. Miller, Chairman presiding, the following business was transacted.

Reading of the minutes of the previous meeting was dispensed with and there being no objection to the same they were ordered to stand approved.

Motion by Commissioner Hopkins, seconded by Commissioner Miller, that a quit claim deed be issued as of October 3rd, 1938, to Georgia B. Bagby on the S. 50' of Lot 6, Block 1, O. T. of Tulsa, on account of error in issuing tax deed in 1938 tax re-sale to Tulsa County; taxes having been paid prior to re-sale by said Georgia B. Bagby. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion by Commissioner Hopkins, seconded by Commissioner Gray, that the resignation of Reynolds Gibbs at the Municipal Hospital be accepted as of September 30th, 1938. Motion carried.

Motion by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner Hopkins, that Mrs. Abbie Hoyle, be and she is hereby appointed nurse at the Municipal Hospital as of October 4th, 1938, at a salary of \$65.00 per month. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

John H. Miller, Chairman, deposited on October 7th, 1938, with the County Treasurer \$6.00 collected from Mrs. Gwin for water, gas and electricity in connection with the lunch counter in the basement, for the month of September, 1938. Receipt No. 18083. Same was ordered filed.

Motion by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner Hopkins, that A. F. Ezzell be allowed \$60.00 expense account per month as of August 1st, 1938; and Dr. O. E. Robinson be allowed \$40.00 expense account per month as of August 1st, 1938. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.
