Gentlemen:-

Pursuant to your instructions with reference to a drainage ditch, proposed to be cut on the north line of the highway which runs along the line between Sections 4 and 9, T. 20 North, Range 13, East, I advertised for bids on the same, and there is hereto attached, the proposal of McBride and Lowrey which is in my opinion a most reasonable bid for the work that we proposed to have done.

I want to recommend that the County abandon its idea to cut this proposed ditch for the reason that the same is not essential to the welfare of the highway, and that the benefits which would result to the County would not be justified by the Expense.

Mr. H.C.Tyrell who owns lands adjacent to this highway has proposed to pay \$2000. toward the cost of constructing the ditch, which proposition on his part was contingent on the County raising the roadbed of the road an elevation of four feet above its present low level. This offer upon his part caused us to first look with favor on the proposition

I am now of the opinion that a levee along the road would cause the raising of water above the road so as to cover lands in flood time not heretofore inundated, and that the ditch we propose would not carry off the run-off in flood times so as to overcome this objection.

Therefore, it is the recommendation that this County not engage in the undertaking, and it is further recommended that this section of the County offers splendid chances for a drainage district, and the taking care of this overflow section of the County should be cared for by the property owners involved, petitioning for the creation of a drainage District.
