THEREFORE, Be it Resolved, that the County Officers of Tulsa County be respectfully requested to file their requisitions for supplies with the County Clerk, to be purchased by the purchasing agent, and in the future bills for supplies must bear the endorsement of the purchasing agent before being allowed.

We further recommend that all supplies for Tulsa County be purchased from Tulsa County dealers when practicable.
