MONDAY, JUNE 17th, 1935.

The Board of County Commissioners met in regular session on Monday, June 17th, 1935, at the hour of 10:00 o'clock A.M., with all members present: John H. Miller, Chairman; J. B. Gray and Harry L. Hopkins, Members. Andy Stokes, County Clerk.

Chairman Miller presiding, the following business was transacted:

Reading of the minutes of the previous meeting was dispensed with and there being no objection to the same they were ordered to stand approved.

Motion was made by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner Hopkins, that the surety bond of the Guaranty Abstract Company, made by the National Surety Corporation, in the sum of \$10,000.00, be approved and filed. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion was made by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner Hopkins, that the monthly report of the County Courts be accepted and filed. All members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion was made by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner Hopkins, that the monthly report of Frank Markham, Clerk, Court of Common Pleas, be accepted and filed. All members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion was made by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner Hopkins, that the monthly report filed by E. A. Watterfield, Court Clerk, for the month ending May 31st, 1935, be accepted and filed. All members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion was made by Commissioner Hopkins, seconded by Commissioner Miller, that the County Commissioners vacate and set aside the ORDER OF TRANSFER made by the County Superintendent, L. H. Cates, on June 1st, 1935, in which twenty-four children were transferred from School District #23 to School District #27, and the County Superintendent, L. H. Cates be instructed to show same upon his records. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was declared carried.

The following Resolution was introduced by Commissioner Gray, who moved its adoption; said motion being seconded by Commissioner Hopkins. Chairman ordered the Resolution read.
