Gentlemen:-

We are about to complete out contracts for the construction of the State Road running from Skiatook to Collinsville and from Owasso to Collinsville and thence to Washington County line, and as our teams and camps are now located immediately near the Caney River Road, known officially as State Road Section C "1", which it is planned to be placed to grade, we the undersigned hereby agree to an extension of our contract on the Owasso-Collinsville-Washington County Road to cover this proposed new work, but however under the process that prevail on the Skiatook Collinsville road, which are lower than on the Owasso-Collinsville-Washington County Line Road, viz, to wit:

WHEREAS, for the tax year 1919, a certain parcel of land known as the Acme Farm embracing the North One Half (N 1/2) of the Northwest quarter (NW 1/4) of the Southwest quarter (SW 1/4) of the Southwest quarter (SW 1/4) of Section Four (4), township Nineteen (19) North, Range Thirteen (13) East, Tulsa County, Oklahoma, was assessed under the foregoing description as one parcel of land, and is so run upon the tax rolls and,

WHEREAS, through a violation of the law the former owner of said tract of land has sold said land in various fixed parcels and tracts to a large number of different persons describing the same by metes and bounds, and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners has heretofore, under authority of law, caused the said Acme Farm to be carefully surveyed and platted into lots and blocks strictly conforming to the divisions theretofore made by transfers on record in Tulsa County, Oklahoma; and

WHEREAS, said Acme Farm is now platted and record thereof filed as such, giving lots and blocks; and

WHEREAS, by reason of failure, neglect, and refusal of the former owner to properly plat into lots and blocks the above described Acme Farm, the County Assessor did, for the tax year ending June 30th, 1919, erroneously assess said Acme Farm as one body of land.
