NOW, On this 31st. day of October, 1927, the matter of the Petition of Beverly Boot and Saddle Club for permission to lay a pipe line along, under and across certain highways in said County and State came up before the Board od County Commissioners of said County for hearing, and it appearing to the Board and each of the Commissioners that it was just that the said Beverly Boot and Saddle Club be permitted to use as much of the highways as designated by plat filed by said corporation, and according to said description which is as follows:

Proposed one and one-quarter inch water pipe line on the South side of the Section line highway between Sections 29 and 32, Township 19 North, Range 13 East, from the West line of Section 32, running East approximately one half mile.

AND, it furter appearing from the Petition herein that said pipe line will be so constructed as not to interfere with any of the rights of the general public in the use of said highways; and will be constructed in accordance with all rules of the County Commissioners and the laws of the State of Oklahoma governing same.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AND ADJUDGED Bythe Board of County Commissioners of said County that per mission be granted, and the same is hereby granted to Beverly Boot and Saddle Club, its successors and assigns, to use as much of the highways as above designated.

Beginning at a point near the Southwest corner of the SE¹/₄ of NE¹/₄ of Sec. 31, Twp. 21, N., Rge. 14 East, and running thence East and Northeasterly to a point near the Northeast corner of Section 29, Twp. 21 N., R 14 E., thereby crossing the North and South Section line highway between Sections 31 and 32, Twp. 21 N., R 14 E., and also crossing the East and West Section line highway between Sections 29 and 32, T 21 N.R 14 E. together with any other public roads or highways that might be crossed by a gas pipe line laid in accordance with blue print map of survey hereto attached and made a part hereof. This line known as "Line (J-W (Henry Gassaway #1) Part Renewal, and "Line J-W (Edna Murphy #1) Extension, a proposed four and five inch gas pipe line.

AND, it further appearing from the petition herein that said pipe line will be so constructed as not to interfere with any of the rights of the general public in the use of said highways; and will be constructed in accordance with all rules of the County Commissioners and the laws of the State of Oklahoma governing same.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AND ADJUDGED by the Board of County Commissioners of said County that permission be granted, and the same is hereby granted to Oklahoma Natural Gas Corporation, its successors and assigns, to use as much of the highways as above designated.
