NOW, On this the 31st. day of October, 1927, the matter of the petition of Oklahoma Natural Gas Corporation for permission to lay a pipe line along, under and across certain highways in said County and State came before the Board of County Commissioners of said County for hearing, and it appearing to the Board and each of the Commissioners thereof that it was just that the said Oklahoma Natural Gas Corporation be permitted to use as much of the highways as designated by plat filed by said corporation, and according to said description, which is as follows, to-wit:

A six and five eighths (6 5/8) inch gas pipe line beginning at a point near the Southwest corner of the intersection of Forty First Street and South Peoria Avenue, Tulsa, Oklahoma, and running thence East across South Peoria Avenue and along Forty First Street (which is the section line highway between Sections 19 and 30, Twp. 19 N., R. 13 E) for a distance of approximately three fourths mile, line to be laid on the south side of said highway.

AND, it further appearing from the petition herein that said pipe line will be so constructed as not to interfere with any of the rights of the general public in the use of said highways; and will be so constructed in accordance with all rules of the County Commissioners and the laws of the State of Oklahoma governing same.
