Hon. Board of Commissioners, Tulsa, Oklahoma.

Gentlemen: -

Whereas a petition has been presented to your Honorable Board asking that a drainage district be created, and the necessary surveys, plans, estimates of cost and etc., be prepared, and whereas this work will require an expansion of the County Engineer's Department and entail the equipment of an organization for this purpose due to the great amount of work now under construction by the County, requiring the continued use of all its present force.

We therefore herewith ternder to your Honorable Board our services for this work.

First: We propose to make all the preliminary surveys, corss sections, contour drainage maps, assessments maps, assessment rolls, flow line sections and estimate of costs, for the proposed drainage ditch/ together with all latteral ditches, contract forms, and bidding sheets, to the satisfaction of the County Engineer and your Hon. Board, for the sum of Three (3) percent of the estimates cost of the work.

SECOND: We propose to furnish on construction, supervision, inspection, monthly estimates, stakes and all necessary construction data, for the guidance of the contractor to the completion and acceptance of the work, and the issuance of the tax warrants or Bonds, for the sum of \_\_\_\_\_\_ per cent of the estimated cost of the work, as shown by the final estimate made to the contractor as may be agreed upon.

This porposal is made subject to the option of your Board, in that wither one or both proposals may be approved.

The cost of engineering being under the law a part of the improvement is chargeable to the property benefited, and if the work is done no sost will accrue to the County, and if the work is abandoned after the surveys are made, the costs of the surveys are to be paid out of the petitioners bond.
