NOW THEREFORE, be it understood and agreed between the sponsors and the Works Progress Administration for Oklahoma for the approval and initiation of this project does not create an obligation on the part of the Works Progress Administration for Oklahoma to complete the project if such reductions are made. In the event of such reductions, the sponsor agrees either to accept the work which has been done at that time and take over the project, carrying the same to completion, or to such an extent that the project will be usable and will not be left in an unsightly or discreditable condition and to conform to such new regulations as may be established from time to time.

In compliance with Sec. 1, Title 1 Emergency Relief Appropriation Act of 1937, the sponsor, by these presents, agrees to finance such part of the entire cost of the said project as is ~~not~~ to be supplied from Federal funds; and the sponsor hereby assumes full responsibility for all of the ~~xx~~ items of materials, equipments, labor, etc. to which they have agreed in the approved 301.

It is further understood and agreed that neither the approval of this project at this time, nor its initiation creates on the part of the Federal Government any commitment, obligation or implied contract for its completion under the conditions which are applicable at the time of its approval.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the sponsor, through its authorized agents, and the Works Progress Administration for Oklahoma, through the State Administrator, have signed this agreement in triplicate on the 28th day of July, 1937.
