Motion made by Commissioner Evans, seconded by Commissioner Couch, and unanimously carried, that the request of the Governing Board of Tulsa County Dependent Separate Schools, totaling \$353.00 for appropriation of State Aid to the General Fund, be and the same is hereby approved and referred to the Excise Board for their consideration.

Moved by Commissioner Couch, seconded by Commissioner Evans, and unanimously carried, that the petition of residents of the town of Dawson, Oklahoma, requesting a census of said town, be accepted and filed, and that the following order with respect thereto be entered:

O R D E R

The petition of residents of the town of Dawson, Oklahoma requesting a census of said town, coming on for hearing pursuant to prior setting thereof, petitioners appearing by their attorneys and there being no objections thereto made or filed, the Board, being fully advised in the premises, finds:

That said petition bears the signatures of one hundred and sixty qualified electors of the town of Dawson, Oklahoma, constituting more than 25% of the qualified electors of said town, as shown by the vote case for the State ticket of the State of Oklahoma at the last preceding general election, held on November 5, 1946; that said petition is in all things sufficient; that by virtue thereof, this Board has jurisdiction to cause an enumeration of the town of Dawson, Oklahoma, to be made, as provided by law, and that such census and enumeration should be made.

That said petitioners represent that said enumeration will be made without cost to the town of Dawson or Tulsa County; that the parties hereinafter designated as census takers, have agreed to waive any and all compensation for their work and petitioners have posted their bond, in the amount of \$500.00, with good and sufficient sureties, indemnifying the town of Dawson, Oklahoma, and Tulsa County, against any cost in connection with the taking of said census and enumeration.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED: That a census and enumeration of the town of Dawson, Oklahoma, be taken forthwith; that

be, and they are hereby, designated and appointed as census takers for the town of Dawson, Oklahoma, to determine the population of said town of Dawson, Oklahoma; that the parties so designated, shall before entering upon their duties, qualify by filing their Oath of Office with the County Clerk of Tulsa County, Oklahoma; that they shall serve without pay and that they shall complete said census and enumeration within sixty (60) days from date hereof; that when said census and enumeration has been determined, the said census takers shall certify the result to this Board, whereupon, it shall be spread upon the records of the Board and a certificate thereof filed in the office of the Secretary of State of the State of Oklahoma, all as provided by law.
