who are three disinterested free holders from the body of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, and who are not owners of any property to be assessed, are hereby appointed to constitute a Board of Appraisers to appraise and apportion the benefits to be received by the construction of said public distribution system to the several lots, parcels and tracts of land in said Water Improvement District No. 18, of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, which said tracts, lots and parcels of land are described in the Schedule hereto attached and which said schedule is referred to and made a part of this resolution; and,

That said appraiser shall, within five (5) days after being notified of their appointment and subscribing their oath to make true and impartial appraisement and apportionment, proceed to perform all such acts and things in the premises as by law they are or will be required and empowered to do, and said appraisers shall make return and report of such appraisment and apportionment to this Board of County Commissioners.
