If awarded the said work, we propose to immediately enter into contract, furnishing an acceptable Surety Company Bond, both contract and statutory in the full amount of the contract price, agreeing to begin the said work within Fifteen (15) days from this date and to complete the same to your acceptance on or before the first day of July, 1928, and upon failure to so complete, the penalties as provided in the Oklahoma State Standard Specifications are hereby agreed to for failure to complete within the time limit proposed.

When mutually agreed to by and between your Honorable Board and ourselves, this proposal may be considered for extension to additional work of the same character and upon the same highway, and as a continuation of the work herein bid upon as though the same were herein originally contained and set out.

Certified Check and (or) Bidder's Bond amounting to \$10,000.00 being 10% of the sum bid and conforming to the requirements of the specifications and "notice to Contractors" is hereto attached.

O R D E R

NOW, On this the 31st. day of October, 1927, the matter of the petition of the Cunningham & Tadder Gas Co., for permission to lay a pipe line along, under and across certain highways in said County and State came up before the Board of County Commissioners of said County for hearing and it appearing to the Board, and each of the Commissioners thereof, that it was just that the said Petitioner be permitted to use as much of the highways as designated by plat filed, and according to said description, which is as follows: to-wit:

Beginning at a point in the Northwest corner of Sec. 31 and following the fence line East to the NE Cor. of Sec. 32, and beginning at a point in the NW Cor. of Sec. 29, and following the fence line South to the SW Cor. of Sec. 32, being four (4) miles, from the point of beginning in Twp. 19, N. R 13 E., Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma.

AND, it appearing from the petition herein that said pipe line will be constructed as not to interfere with any rights of the general public in the use of said highways, and will be constructed in accordance with all rules of the County Commissioners and the laws of the State of Oklahoma governing the same.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AND ADJUDGED by the Board of County Commissioners of said County that permission be granted and the same is hereby granted to the Cunningham and Tadder Gas Co., their successors and assigns to use as much of the highways as above designated.
