Notice is, hereby, given that on the 2nd day of October 1916, the County Commissioners of said County appointed John Kramer, John L. Smiley, and F.M. Wooden to view, lay out, survey and appraise a road upon and along the following line to-wit:

A strip of land 60 fet. wide adjacent parrallel and South of the St.L & S.F.R.R. center line described as follows: Beginning at a point 589 30' W. 924 feet from 5 $\frac{1}{4}$ corner Sec. 22, Twp 19 North, Range 12 East, thence South 47 degrees W. a distance $\frac{1}{2}$ of 2345 feet, thence at an angle to the left and along a 1 degree curve 960 feet, thence South 36 degrees 35' W. a distance of 2472.3 ft., thence at an angle to the right and along a 1 degree curve a distance of 806.6 ft., thence South 46 degrees 20' West a distance of 3452.1 feet, thence at an angle to the right along a 2 degree curve a distance of 1795. feet to the intereccion of the present road known as the Tulsa-Sapulpa Road and that said viewers with the County Engineer of said County will meet at the beginning point of said road on the 31st day of October 1916, at 10 O'clock A.M. and proceed to view, survey and appraise said road and give all parties a hearing.
