Motion made by Commissioner Kinkaid, seconded by Commissioner Greer, to accept the resignation of Mr. William M. Taylor, as Civil Assistant County Attorney, effective April 1, 1944. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.
