A resolution was passed accepting the proposal of C.M.Pritchard for leasing rock crusher located at Price and authorizing the County Attorney to draw up a contract for the same as per bids advertised for bridge building.

The following bids were received. Bid of the Canton Bridge Company, \$3,346.00 Oklahoma Iron Works, \$3,600.00 Canton Bridge Company being the lowest bidder, and order was made that the Canton Bridge Company be awarded the Contract and they were instructed to file bond with the County Clerk.

RESOLUTION.

IN THE MATTER OF SURFACING THE TULSA-SAPULPA HIGHWAY.

The proposal of J.T.Lantry to furnish all materials and labor for the construction of a listomastic paving with macadam base was considered.

It was moved by A.W.Lucas and seconded by Ed.Baker to award the contract for the construction of the price named in the proposal of \$ 6,935.00 per mile, to the said J.T.Lantry with the following provisions to be incorporated in the contract..

(a) The stone for the improvement is to be delivered to the site of work and distributed in load piles by Tulsa County as directed by the Contractor. The value of the crushed stone calculated at the rate of \$1.75 per cubic yard delivered, based on the thickness shown in the plans and specifications, shall be deducted from the monthly estimate of the Contractor. Should it be deemed advisable at certain points to use additional crushed rock, giving an added thickness to the base, the contract or will not be expected to pay for this additional or extra stone over and above the specified standard thickness.

(b) As the contract is based on mileage rate of the specified width, the Board of County Commissioners reserve the right to change the width, or increase or decrease the length or road with settlement based on a proportional price of the contract price.
