

16.5 feet wide, north of and adjacent to the present County road right of way, along the south line of said SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 31, containing 0.25 acres, more or less. The present County road right of way is 16.5 feet on each side of the Section line.

AND, WHEREAS, Tulsa County has been unable to affect an amicable settlement in the matter of the said strip of land owned by George A Hugo.

AND, WHEREAS, it is necessary to acquire said strip of land for right of way purposes by condemnation proceedings.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the County Attorney in the name of the Board for and on behalf thereof, be and he is hereby instructed to institute condemnation proceedings in the District Court of this County for the purpose of condemning said above described tract of land for County highway purposes.

All members of the Commission voting in the affirmative, the motion was declared carried, and the Resolution adopted.

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The following Resolution was introduced by Mr. Hedgecock, who moved its adoption, said motion being seconded by Mr. Dickey, and the Chairman ordered the Resolution read:

#### R E S O L U T I O N

WHEREAS, Sec. 9983, Chap. 85, C O S, provides, that "All section lines in the State are hereby declared public highways. The public highways shall not be less than thirty three, nor more than sixty-six feet in width, according to the dedication, reservation or condemnation thereof",

AND, WHEREAS, An Act of Congress to ratify and confirm a supplemental agreement with the Creek Tribe of Indians, approved June 30th. 1902; ratified July 26, 1902, effective August 8, 1902, provides, among other things "That public highways or roads three (3) rods in width, being one and one-half rods on each side of the section line, may be established along all section lines without any compensation being paid therefor; and all allottees, purchasers, and others shall take the title to such lands subject to this provision".

AND, WHEREAS, it becomes necessary for Tulsa County to establish a highway along a section line in the Creek Nation, the West end of which has not previously been opened as a public highway.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the entire mile between Sections Twenty Three (23) and Twenty Six (26), Township Nineteen (19) North, Range Twelve (12), East 1/2, West 41st. Street in Red Fork Township, be opened as a public highway.

All voting in the affirmative, the motion was declared carried, and the Resolution adopted as read.
