R E S O L U T I O N

A Resolution authorizing and directing the County Treasurer of Tulsa County to sell certain bonds purchased with the Sinking Funds of said County and now the property of said County.

WHEREAS, there are now in the Sinking Funds of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, \$50,000.00 Comanche, Oklahoma Sewer Bonds, dated May 24, 1921, and maturing as follows:

No's 41 to 60, inc.	\$20,000.00	May 24, 1931
No's 61 to 90, inc.	30,000.00	May 24, 1936

WHEREAS, it is deemed advisable, and to the best interests of the County, by the County Treasurer and the Board of County Commissioners of said Tulsa County, to dispose of said Bonds for cash, Now, Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED, BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF TULSA COUNTY, STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

THAT the County Treasurer of said County is hereby authorized and empowered to sell and deliver the above described bonds for par and accrued interest and to do all things necessary to effect such sale and delivery.
