An order was made that the State Road from the South Side of the West Tulsa to Creek County line be changed and same be located on the South side of the Frisco Right of way instead of its present location, and same be so designated on County Road Maps.

The plans and specifications of S. W. Mitchell, County Engineer, be submitted to Board of County Commissioners showing an approximate cost of the West Tulsa-Keystone Road and showing the same road being appraisable and needing a road way. There was an order be the Board of Commissioners that said road way be designated, grading and other work Commissioners that said road way be designated, grading and other work necessary to complete same State Road be done at once. Motion prevailed.
