

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS of Tulsa County that it is in their opinion to the best interest of Tulsa County that a concrete drainage opening be constructed on the West Side of the paved road at the intersection of Sections One (1) Two (2), Eleven (11) and Twelve (12) Township Eighteen (18) North, Range Thirteen (13) East, to cost not more than Five Hundred (\$500.00) Dollars; also, the construction of two (2) small culverts between Sections Five (5) and Six (6) Township Twenty (20) North, Range Thirteen (13) East, to cost not to exceed Six Hundred (\$600.00) Dollars each; and that Contract No. 82A of A.C. Bancroft be and the same is hereby extended to cover these openings to be constructed under the direction of the County Engineer.
