Motion made by Commissioner Greer, seconded by Commissioner Gray, that the appointment of John Paul and Phoebe Evans, Deputies, in the office of the County Treasurer, effective September 1, 1946, at a salary of \$180.00^{per month}/each, be and the same are hereby approved. Upon roll call, all member voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion made by Commissioner Gray, to rescind the motion made and seconded on January 14, 1946, turning all buildings located at the Fair Grounds, together with the NYA Buildings, with the exception of the armory, ball park, three buildings used by District #3, and the one leased to the American War Moms^{over to the Fair Board.} Motion died for want of a second.

Motion made by Commissioner Bailey, seconded by Commissioner Gray, that A. V. Parker, Bixby, be appointed Constable in District #7, replacing W. M. Benton, who has moved away. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion made by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner Greer, that a recess be taken until 2:00 o'clock P. M. Motion carried.

A petition was presented by Joseph A. Moran requesting the closing of part of Section line between Section Thirty-two (32), Township Nineteen (19) North, Range Thirteen (13) East and Section Five (5), Township Eighteen (18) North, Range Thirteen (13) East, and that authority be given by the Board of County Commissioners to proceed with the advertising and that hearing be set for September 30, 1946; and bond to cover the cost be fixed at \$100.00, surety bond acceptable. Motion made by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner Greer that this be done. Upon roll call, both members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion made by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner Greer, that the report filed by Cameron Cline, Court Clerk, for the County Court Division, for the month of August, 1946, be and the same is hereby accepted and filed. Upon roll call, both members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.
