> > RECORDS OF COMMISSIONERS DISTRICT AND JUSTICE OF

THE PEACE DISTRICTS SUPPLIED.

WHEREAS, the orders of the County Commmissioners of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, creating three Commissioners districts and eleven justice of the peace districts made at the regular meeting of said Commissioners in July, 1910, were omitted and left out of the records of said meeting;

BE IT RESOLVED, That the records be and the same are hereby supplied and ordered entered of record, as follows:

COMMISSIONERS DISTRICTS CREATED.

Commission-

It is hereby ORDERED by the Board of County Commissioners that three commissioners districts be and the same are hereby greated as required by Section 1654, Snyders Statutes of 1909, as follows:

District No. 1 shall be composed of Skiatook Township, Owasso Township, Dawson Township and all of that part of the City of Tulsa lying East of Main Street and North of Second Street extended to the city limits.

District No. 2 shall be composed of all territory within the incorporated limits of the city of Tulsa, except that part lying North of Second Street extended to the city limits and East of Main Street.

District No. 3 shall be composed of all of that part of Lynn Lane Township lying and being outside of the incorporated limits of the city of Tulsa, all of Bowles Township, Fry Township, Willow Springs Township, Jenks Township, Red Fork Township, Wekiwa Township and Bixby Township.

JUSTICE OF THE PEACE DISTRICTS.

It is hereby ordered by the County Commissioners of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, that eleven justice of the peace districts shall be and are hereby created, numbered from one to eleve, inclusive, as follows:

District No. 1 shall be composed of all of Skiatook Township. District No. 2 shall be composed of all of Owasso Township. District No. 3 shall be composed of all of Dawson Township.

District No. 4 shall be composed of the incorporated city of Tulsa.

District No. 5 shall be composed of all of that part of Lynn Lane

District No. 5 shall be composed of all of the city of Tulsa.

Township lying outside of the incorporated limits of the city of Tulsa. District No. 6 shall be composed of all of Bowles Township, Fry

Township and Willow Springs Township. District No. 7 shall be composed of all of that part of Bixby Township lying east of a line beginning at the northeast corner of Section 5, Township 17 North, Range 13 East, and running south along section line to the County line.

District No. 8 shall be composed of all of that part of Bixby Township lying west of a line beginning at the northeast corner of Section 5, Township 17 North, Range 13 east and running south along section hine to the County line.

District No. 9 shall be composed of all of Jenks Township.
District No. 10 shall be composed of all of Red Fork Township. District No. 11 shall be composed of all of Wekiwa Township.
