

On this 20th day of September 1920, the application of the Oklahoma Gas and Electric Company, for the use of certain roads and highways of Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma, was presented at a regular meeting of the Board of County Commissioners, and said application was heard. The following commissioners were present:

After hearing a discussion of the said application the following resolution upon motion duly made and seconded, was unanimously carried.

WHEREAS, the Oklahoma Gas and Electric Company, under date of August 4th 1920, has made application for the use of certain roads and highways for the purpose of transmitting and selling gas and electricity, and

WHEREAS, it appears that said company is entitled, under the laws, to use the said highways for such purposes, and

WHEREAS, it appears that such use of such roads and highways is to be the best interest of the citizens of Tulsa County, and particularly of the cities and towns located upon and along the routes indicated in said application.

NOW THEREFORE, Be It Resolved that we, the Board of County Commissioners in regular meeting do hereby give our consent to the use of the following roads and highways in Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma, be the Oklahoma Gas & Electric Company, its successors and assigns, for the purpose of transmitting and selling the gas and electricity, to-wit:-

The roads and highways to be used under this application and resolution are wholly within Tulsa County, Oklahoma, and are more particularly described as follows: to-wit:-

"Beginning at a point where the East and West Section Line between section 34, township 18 North, Range 12 East, and section 3, Township 17 north, Range 12 East, intersects with the North and South Section line between Sections three (3) and Four (4), township seventeen (17) North, Range twelve (12) East, thence running along and upon the East and West section line in an easterly direction, a distance of four miles, more or less, to the North and south section line between sections five and six, township seventeen (17) north, range thirteen (13) east; thence running along said last named North and south section line, a distance of two miles more or less, in a northerly direction to the east and west section line between sections 19 and 30, township 18 north, range 13 east; thence running in a westerly direction and running thence along said last named east and west section line, a distance of one mile, more or less, to the north and south section line, between section 19, township 18 north, range 13 east, thence turning in a northerly direction and along and upon said last named north and south section line, a distance of one mile more or less to the east and west section line, between sections eighteen and nineteen (18 & 19) Township eighteen (18) North, ~~thence~~ Range 13 East; Thence turning in a westerly direction and along and upon said last named east and west section line, a distance of one mile more or less, to the north and south section line, between sections 13 and 14, township 18 north, range 12 east; thence turning in a northerly direction and along and upon said last named North and south section line, a distance of three miles, more or less, to the east and west section line between section 36, township 19 north, range 12 east, and Section 1, Township 18 North, Range 12 East."

Consent is also hereby given that the right of way above described, shall include the right to cross all highways and roads intersecting any of the routes above described, and shall include the right to erect and maintain, where required, necessary stubs and guy wires.

The consent hereinbefore given, however, being subject to the following conditions, and rules and regulations:-

The said Oklahoma Gas and Electric Company shall place and maintain its poles, or lay its pipes or conduits upon, along, across, or under such roads and highways under the supervision of the Board of County Commissioners, and not to exceed eight feet from the side of the road or highway used, and shall remove, at its expense, from the lines of said poles, pipes or conduits, to the ground level ~~xxx~~ any and all trees or obstructions that might interfere or come in contact with such poles, pipes or conduits, and shall pay for the cost of publishing this resolution upon demand of the County Clerk. The acceptance of the consent hereinbefore given by the said Oklahoma Gas and Electric Company shall be a promise and covenant on their part to defend all law suits, and satisfy and take care of all judgments rendered by reason of accident growing out of the occupancy of the highway by said company under this consent.
