to connect with a water line on the premises owned by C. F. Tingley; said water line to be laid and maintained subject to the approval of the County Engineer of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, and with the express agreement that Bruner Hill Improvement Club would save Tulsa County, Oklahoma, free and harmless from any claims for expense for the furnishing of Water for said Park and in the laying, constructing and maintenance of said water line.
