O R D E R

NOW, On this the 15th. day of June, 1925, the matter of the petition of the Oklahoma Natural Gas Company for permission to lay a pipe line along, under and across certain highways in said County and State came up before the Board of County Commissioners of said County for hearing, and it appearing to the Board, and each of the Commissioners thereof, that it was just that the said Oklahoma Natural Gas Company be permitted to use as much of the highways as designated by plat filed by said Company, and according to said description, which is as follows, to-wit:

Beginning at a point near the Southwest corner of the North Half of the Southwest Quarter of Section 3, Township 18 North Range 12 East, and running thence Northeasterly to a point within the Southeast Quarter of Section 26, Township 19, North, Range 12 East, known as Oklahoma Natural Gas Company's South River Station, thereby crossing the North and South Sections 3 & 4, Township 18 North, Range 12 East, and Sections 34 & 35, Township 19 North, Range 12 East, and crossing the East and West Section lines between Section 3, Township 18 North, Range 12 East, and Section 34, Township 19 North, Range 12 East, and between Sections 35 - 26, Township 19 North, Range 12 East known as "Line A-M-53 (Extension)", a sixteen inch gas pipe line.

Insofar as pertains to roads and highways under control of the Board of County Commissioners of Tulsa County, Oklahoma.

And it further appearing from the petition herein that said pipe line will be so constructed as not to interfere with any of the rights of the general public in the use of said highways; and will be constructed in accordance with all rules of the County Commissioners and the laws of the State of Oklahoma governing same.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AND ADJUDGED By the Board of County Commissioners of said County that permission be granted and the same is hereby granted to the Oklahoma Natural Gas Company, its successors and assigns, to use as much of the highways as above designated.

INDUSTRIAL LEASE.

Beginning at a point Three Hundred fifty (350) feet West and Thirty Three (33) feet North of the Southeast corner of Section Nine (9), Township Nineteen (19) North, Range Thirteen (13) East and running thence North Fifty (50) feet; thence West One Hundred
