NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That the County Engineer be and he is here by directed to prepare plans and specifications and to advertise for bids for the construction of the necessary drainage structures on Sheridan Drive between Sections 2 & 3, T 19 N., R 13 E., and between Sections 34-35, 27-26, T 20 N., R 13 E. Also, Uhrig Hill netween sections 4-33, T wp and 21, R 13 E.

All voting in the affirmative, the motion was declared adopted.

In the matter of the petition of the Oklahoma Natural Gas Corporation for permission to lay pipe line along certain highways, the following order was made:

ORDER.

NOW, On this the 14th. day of November, 1927, the matter of the Petition of the Oklahoma Natural Gas Corporation for permission to la y a pipe line under, through and across certain highways in said County and State, came up before the Board of County Commissioners of said County for hearing, and it appearing to the Board and each of the Commissioners thereof that it was just that the said Oklahoma Natural Gas Copration be permitted to use as much of the highways as designated by plat filed by said corporation, and according to said Description which is as follows, to-wit:

Along Kansas Avenue, on the west side thereof, from a point near the southwest cofner of the intersection of Kansas Ave. and Broadway (48th.Street) to a point near the center of the east line of Lot 8, Block 7, Carbondale Third Addition; also along Lincoln Ave. (50th.St) on the north side thereof, from the foregoing line near the northwest corner of the intersection of Lincoln Ave. (50th.St) and Kansas Ave. to a point near the northeast corner of the intersection of Lincoln Ave. (50th.St), and Oklahoma Ave. being in Carbondale Third Addition covering the SE½ of SE½ of Sec. 28, Twp 19 N., R 12 E., as shown on blue print hereto attached and made a part hereof. This line known as "Service Lines-City of Tulsa", a proposed four inch gas pipe line.

And, it further appearing from the petition herein that said pipe line will be so constructed as not to interfere with any of the rights of the general public in the use of said highways, and will be constructed in accordance with all rules of the County Commissioners and the laws of the State of Oklahoma governing same.

IT IS HEREBY OR DERED AND ADJUDGED by the Board of County Commissioners of said County that permission be granted, and the same is hereby granted to Oklahona Natural Gas Corporation, its successors and assigns, to use as much of the highways as above designated.
