This memorandum of agreement made and entered into this the 4th day of October, 1920, by and between the Commissioners of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, party of the first part, and the Standard Paving Company, a corporation, parties of the second part.

WITNESSETH: That, pursuant to a notice published as prescribed by law, and the opening and consideration of bids received, it was found that the bid made by the second party was the best bid filed,

NOW THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the sum of Three and 25/10 (\$3.25) Dollars per square yard for concrete paving and one (\$1.00) Dollar per cubic yard for trench excavation, the said second party hereby agrees to construct that part of the Tulsa County State Highway lying between the Jenks-Arkansas River Bridge and the East end of the Main Street of the City of Jenks, Oklahoma, said work to be done and material used as set out in a certain contract and specifications known as Contract No. 12 Tulsa County, for the paving of Miles three (3) and Four (4) of Section "S".

Said second party further agrees to complete said work within Sixty (60) days from the date of this agreement.

All payments to be made by the first party as provided in the contract above referred to. Said Contract No. 12, and its bond to remain in full force and effect until the completion and acceptance of the first party of the work contemplated in this agreement.
