The Board of County Commissioners met in their rooms at 1:30 P. M. Mr. North and Mr. Wooley, present and Mr. Sanders, absent.

Upon motion Mr. North was elected temporary chairman.

Upon motion, the report of viewers, E. L. Morgan, John Polston and Frank Wolf, for the following described road in Dawson township was approved:

Beginning upon Market Street where it intersects lots 13, 14 and the North 10 feet of Lot 15, thence due west upon a projection of the center-line of aforesaid Market Street of Town of Dawson, Okla., across stone quarry. Thence along Market Street to the dividing line between the NE 1/4 SW 1/4 and NW 1/4 SW 1/4 Sec. 27, T. 20 N., R. 13 E., thence South to the St. Louis & San Francisco Ry. Boundary, thence along and adjoining the aforesaid Ry. boundary to an intersection with the Section Line between Secs. 28 and 33, thence West along said section line.

We, do hereby certify these findings to Hon. L. M. Poe, Judge of the District Court of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, and request that the said L. M. Poe, Judge of the District Court of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, appoint three disinterested freeholders from the regular jury list of names prepared for the District Court, who are not interested in the construction of said work, and not of kin to any person interested therein, to act as viewers in the further proceedings in connection with said Drainage District No. 2.


