Gentlemen:-

I, Frank C. Carter, State Auditor of the State of Oklahoma and secretary to the State Board of Equalization hereby certify that the State Board of Equalization has made a levy of one quarter of a mill for the support of common schools and one quarter of one mill for the State Highway Construction, which is hereby certified to you for extension on your tax rolls.

At a recent meeting of the State Board of Equalization, by a majority vote, a tax levy of one and one half mills was made for general fund purposes, however Mr. Carter and Mr. Parkinson contrnded that such levy is illegal and it perhaps will not be certified to the County assessors until such time as the legality of the question is passed upon by the office of the attorney General or the Courts, and I suggest that you do not extend the one and one half mill levy until the same is certified to you by this office.

I further certify that the total valuation of all property as Fixed by the State Board of Equalization and charged to your county is as follows.

The resignation of Mrs. E. C. Lamb as superintendent of the Tulsa County Home was filed with and accepted by the Board of County Commissioners, effective immediately.

The reports of The County Clerk, Register of Deeds Department, The County Treasurer, and James Woolley, Sheriff, Boarding Prisoners, all for the month of September, 1920, were filed with and approved by the Board of County Commissioners.

The Affidavits of Erroneous Assessment filed by the Methodist Episcopal Church of Turley, Oklahoma, E. D. Shaw, and Chas. H. Howard for Leslie Rogers, were by the Board ordered "Stricken."

In the matter of the Park View Drainage District: A contract and Bond having been filed with the Board of County Commissioners, and viewers having been appointed to view the said proposed drainage district, the Board finds that the said viewers so appointed are at this meeting ready to make report to the Board, and that the report submitted in writing is as follows, to wit:

#### REPORT OF VIEWERS.

To the Honorable Board of County Commissioners, of Tulsa County, Oklahoma.

We, the undersigned, being the viewers appointed by your Honorable Board on the 7th day of September, 1920, to view the lines of proposed drains in Drainage District petitioned for by Brady Brown, L. J. Martin, L. L. Wyatt, et al, report that with the County Engineer and under your directions and orders made and entered of record in the proceedings of your Honorable Board, we have viewed ~~xxx~~the poposed lines of drains petitioned for, and report thereof by actual viewers as follows, to wit:-

1: We find the said proposed drains are preaticable, and necessary for the reason that under the present conditions a great portion of the territory embraced in said drainage district is so wet as to mae it impossible to cultivate or improve same; also making it very difficult to build highways or improve the. Further the health of the community is seriously effected by reason of the large area of wet land and stagnant water, we firther find that the physical formation of the country is such that the porposed drain may be constructed at a reasonable cost, and will thereby produce great benefit to the country embraced in the said drainage district.

2: We find that the said proposed drains woul d be of great/public utility and benefit, by alleviating all the evil conditions above noted, by rendering the community a much more healthful place, by making public construction, maintenance of good roads, and by redeeming for agricultural purposes, a large part of the land embraced in the said district, and rendering the same valuable and thereby greatly increasing the taxable and revenue producing property of the said district.

3: We recommend that said drains be laid out, established and constructed along the lines as follows: Begging near the North and South center line of Lot 2, of section 11, township 19, range 12, at the Arkansas River, thence Northerly through lot 2 and lot seven of Section two, township 19, range 12, thence thru the northeast quarter of Lot 8, of Section three (3), Township 19, Range 12, thence northwesterly, through the north half of the Southeast quarter of section three, township 19, range 12 to a point approximately 660 feet south of the center of 3-19-12, thence northwesterly through the North one half of the southwest quarter of section 3, township 19 north, range 12, to a point approximately 200 feet south of the east and west center line of sections three (3) and four (4) township 19, range 12, thencesouthwest erly throught the North one half of the southeast quarter of section 4, township 19, range 12,
