

comprises the intersection between the Northwest corner of Block Three (3) and the Northeast corner of Block Seven (7) and the Southeast corner of Block Eight (8) and the Southwest corner of Block Two (2)

for the reason that the said streets above described have never been actually used for town or City purposes, and are outside and not within the limits of the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma, and have never been used by the Public, and that no lots have been sold within the blocks contiguous to said streets or North thereof, and that the same do not form any part or connection of any street, alley or public highway, and that said property is not adapted to use for residential purposes, and will be valuable for the purposes of using it as trackage, factory, storage and other industrial purposes, because the same lies contiguous and along the side of the right of way of the St. Louis- San Francisco Railway Company and is cut off from communication with any land North thereof by said Right of Way.

It is therefore ordered by the Board of County Commissioners, duly assembled in regular session, that the said streets, to-wit:

Birmingham Place, designated on the original plat of said Addition as Liberty Avenue, lying contiguous to and coterminous with Block Thirteen (13) up to the Southerly East and West Line of Reserve F; and Block Ten (10) in said Addition; and,

Columbia Avenue, designated on the original plat of said Addition as McCoy Avenue, lying contiguous to and coterminous with Block Ten (10) and Block Seven (7) and

Columbia Place, designated on the original plat of said Addition as Wilson Avenue, lying contiguous to and coterminous with Block Seven (7) and Block Three (3) in said Addition and

King Place, designated on the original plat of said addition as North Street, lying contiguous and coterminous with Block Two (2), and Block Three (3) in said Addition; and

All that piece, part of parcel of said Addition which comprises the intersection between the Northwest Corner of Block Three (3) and the Northeast Corner of Block Seven (7) the Southeast Corner of Block Eight (8) and the Southwest corner of Block Two (2)

be and the same are hereby closed and vacated, and that the fee simple title thereto revert to and vest in the owners of the property contiguous thereto in proportion as they own frontage thereon.
