Wekiwa Twp. Road

Moved by Mr. North and seconded by Mr. Wooley that report of Viewers and County Surveyor on road in Wekiwa Township be approved. Motion prevailed. Description of road as follows: Beginning one-half mile North of the South-east corner of the Sec. 10 T.19 N. R. 11 E. and running West 60 feet wide on the half section line through Sec. 10 T. 19 N. R. 11 E. to the M. K. & T. Ry. Co's right of way, thence west ward along the North side of said M. K. & T. Ry. Co's right of way and paralell thereto (except at two places) to the Wekiwa station upon said R. R.-The road in no place to be nearer than 25 feet from end of R. R. ties; the center line of proposed Highway to be 30 feet from aforesaid R. R. boundary line, the road to be 60 feet in width.

Pipeline petition

Moved by Mr. North and seconded by Mr. Wooley that the petition of the Fields Gas Co to construct pipe lines over, under, along and across the public highways of Tulsa County Oklahoma, be granted. Motion prevailed, all members voting "Aye". (See files).
