TUESDAY MAY 16th, 1944

Pursuant to recess heretofore taken, the Tulsa County Commissioners reconvened at the hour of 2:00 o'clock P. M., with all members present: J. B. Gray, Chairman, Curtis Greer and Robt. L. Kinkaid, Members. Andy Stokes, County Clerk.

J. B. Gray, Chairman presiding, the following business was transacted.

Motion made by Commissioner Kinkaid, seconded by Commissioner Gray, to accept the resignation of Mrs. Pearl Haugh, effective May 12th, 1944. I desire to resign as Caseworker in District #3. I have enjoyed my work very much, but feel since school is out that I owe it to my children to be at home with them. Thanking you for the kindness extended to me, I am, Most respectfully, Pearl Haugh. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion made by Commissioner Kinkaid, seconded by Commissioner Gray, to appoint Mrs. Grace Bauder, as Caseworker in the Welfare Department, in District No. 3, at a salary of \$155.00 per month, effective May 13th, 1944. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion made by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner Kinkaid, to accept the resignation of Herman Haiflich, Truck Driver in the Highway Department, District No. 1, effective May 15th, 1944, ~~at a salary of \$170.00 per month~~. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion made by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner Kinkaid to appoint Tom Tinker, to replace Herman Haiflich, as Truck Driver in the Highway Department, District No. 1, effective May 1, 1944, at a salary of \$170.00 per month. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion made by Commissioner Greer, seconded by Commissioner Kinkaid, authorizing the Chairman to sign claim in favor of Joe T. Parkinson, County Treasurer, covering special assessments against County property in Drainage District No. 12, in the amount of \$15,000.00. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried. Claim No. 357717.

Motion made by Commissioner Kinkaid, seconded by Commissioner Gray, to approve Claim No. 357718 Frye Drainage District, in favor of Penoco Oil Company, for supplies, in the amount of \$76.04, and a warrant is ordered issued to cover. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.
