The Bond of H.L.Standeven as County Judge was presented to the Board and approved with the United States Fidelity and Guranty Company of Baltimore, Md., as surety in the sum of Five Thousand(\$ 5,000.00) Dollars.

The following resolution was adopted by the Board of County Commissioners ,  
 "WHEREAS, the cattle dipping vat at the town of Keystone, which was built jointly by the counties of Tulsa, Creek and Pawnee, is now in disuse, owing to defects in the vats, and WHEREAS, John F.Hayden has constructed on his ranch in Section Eleven (11) Township 19 North, Range Nine (9) East, a vat at which the cattle of Alexander, and Wilson, in Tulsa County are being dipped, and WHEREAS, it is necessary for said Hayden to have more material to complete the stock yards in connection with the vat on his ranch.

THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Board of County Commissioners of Tulsa County, that said John F.Hayden be allowed to take the gates and fencing, ad such other material as may be necessary from the vat at Keystone, and put same in use at his ranch aforesaid with the understanding that all cattle in the Northwestern portion of Tulsa County be permitted to use the dipping vat on said Hayden's ranch for the purpose of eradicating the Texas cattle fever tick.

An order was made by Cyrus S.Avery that the County Election Board by ordered to deposit all election boxes in their custody in the vault at the foot of the stairs in the basement of the Tulsa County Court House and that they be given exclusive charge of this vault, together, with any keys , combinations, and other equipment in order that they may be able to carry out their duty as members of the Tulsa County Election Board.

B Bids for the construction of an approach for Bridge No.12, Between Secs.1 and 12, Twp 19, range 13, East, were received from the Western Bridge Company and the Canton Bridge Company.

The Bid of the Western Bridge Company being \$1962.00 and that of the Canton Bridge Company \$1595.00. Contract was awarded to the Canton Bridge Company.

A motion was made by Cyrus S.Avery that J.S.Greer and Sons be awarded the contract for road work on the Price & Fisher road, as per bids submitted , and that the numbers of miles be designated by the County Engineer.
