In the matter of the petition of the Oklahoma Natural Gas Company for permission to lay pipe lines, over, under and across certain of the County Highways, in Tulsa County, the following Orders were made:

## - O R D E R -

Comes now, Oklahoma Natural Gas Corporation, a corporation organized and existing under and by virtue of the laws of the state of Maryland, with offices in Tulsa, Oklahoma, and hereby petitions your Honorable Board for the right to lay a pipe line, under, through and across certain highways, as shown by accompanying plat, and described as follows:

Beginning at a point approximately 500 feet South and approximately 30 feet West of the Northeast corner of Section 18, Twp 19 N., Rnge 13 E., and running thence South and along the West side of South Lewis Avenue to 23rd. Street, which street is the south line of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of said Sec. 18, and running thence West along 23rd. Street approximately 200 feet to a point near the northwest corner of Lot 1, of Block 1, Wildwood Add. to the City of Tulsa, and thence running South into said Lot 1. This line known as "Service Lines-City of Tulsa", a proposed eight inch gas pipe line, and located in accordance with blue print map hereto attached and made a part hereof.

Petitioner agrees to keep said line in good condition at all times, and to bury said line below grade, and to maintain in a proper manner backfilled trench and to keep such line and appurtenances thereunto belonging in a good and safe condition at all time, and make changes in such line when ordered to do so by the proper authorities of such County when it is necessary for the construction, improvement, or repair of the public highway, under through and across which said line is located.

Furthermore, petitioner agrees to comply with all rules of the County Commissioners and the laws of the State of Oklahoma in the construction of said pipe line.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AND ADJUDGED by the Board of County Commissioners of said County that permission be granted, and the same is hereby granted to Oklahoma Natural Gas Corporation, its successors and assigns, to use as much of the Highways as above designated.

## - O R D E R -

NOW, on this the 28th. day of November, 1927, the matter of the petition of Okla. Natural Gas Corp. for permission to lay a pipe line, under through and across certain highways in said County and State, came up before the Board of County Commissioners of said County for hearing, and it appearing to the Board and each of the Commissioners thereof that it was just that the said Oklahoma Natural Gas Corporation be permitted to use as much of the highways as designated by plat filed by said corporation, and according to said description, which is as follows:

Beginning at a point near the northwest corner of the intersection of East Eleventh Street and Terre Haute Avenue, said point also being described as near the SE corner of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Sec. 4, Twp. 19 N., Rnge. 13 E., and running thence South across Eleventh Street, and along the West side of said Terre Haute Ave. to a point near the center of the East line of Lot 13, Block 4, of Beverly Hill Add. which addition covers the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Sec. 9, Twp 19 N., Rnge. 13 East. This line to be known as "Service Lines - City of Tulsa," a proposed four and one-half inch gas pipe line, and is definitely located on the blue print map hereto attached and made a part hereof.

And, it further appearing from the petition herein that said pipe line will be so constructed as not to interfere with any of the rights of the general public in the use of said highways, and will be constructed in accordance with all rules of the County Commissioners and the laws of the State of Oklahoma governing same.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AND ADJUDGED by the Board of County Commissioners of said County that permission be granted, and the same is hereby granted to Oklahoma Natural Gas Corporation, its successors and assigns, to use as much of the highways as above designated.
