Motion prevailed.

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An order or petition of N.R.Graham, President of Park Board, as per plans for promoting and helping, and also there was further shown that the bridge between sections 18 and 19, Twp 19, Range 12 and 13. The said bridge was too low, and would be a menace to a large lake now under sonstruction at said location. There was an order by the Board that said bridge at the above named location be raised three feet higher and widened to a width of 22 feet, it being further agreed, by said Park Board that the Park Board would contribute \$75.00 to the County to help defray the expenses of raising said bridge.
