TUESDAY, SEPTEMBER 24, 1946

Pursuant to recess heretofore taken, the Board of County Commissioners reconvened at the hour of 2:00 o'clock P. M. with all members present: J. B. Gray, Chairman; Curtis Greer and Claude W. Bailey, Members. Andy Stokes, County Clerk.

J. B. Gray, Chairman presiding, the following business was transacted.

Motion made by Commissioner Greer, seconded by Commissioner Bailey, that the action of the Board on Tuesday, September 19, 1946, setting the date of Tuesday, December 3, 1946, as the date for a special election to be held to vote on the \$1,250,000.00 bond issue for the construction of a 200-bed hospital, and a \$250,000.00 bond issue for the construction of a bridge across the Arkansas River at Jenks, be and the same is hereby rescinded, and the date of the special election be changed to Tuesday, November 26, 1946. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion made by Commissioner Greer, seconded by Commissioner Bailey, that the Chairman of the Board be and hereby is authorized to write a letter to the County Attorney advising him of the change in the date of the election, and instructing him to prepare papers necessary to hold the election on November 26, 1946. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion made by Commissioner Greer, seconded by Commissioner Gray, that the motion made and seconded on September 19, 1946, awarding Layman and Company the contract covering the improving and surfacing of County Highway from Jenks to U S 169, Project No. 2-E be and the same is hereby rescinded. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion made by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner Bailey, that the Standard Paving Company be and hereby is awarded the contract covering the improving and surfacing of County Highway from Jenks to U. S. 169, a distance of 1.939 miles, for a total amount of \$39,037.00. Standard Paving Company being the low bidder on Project No. 2-E. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion made by Commissioner Greer, seconded by Commissioner Bailey, that the Contract, Statutory and Performance Bonds with the Standard Paving Company on Project No. 2-E covering the surfacing and improving of County Highway from Jenks to U. S. 169, a distance of 1.939 miles, be and the same are hereby approved and the Chairman of the Board is hereby authorized to sign same. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion made by Commissioner Greer, seconded by Commissioner Bailey, that the Contract, Statutory and Performance Bonds with Standard Paving Company on Project No. 2-H covering the improving of County Highway from Glenpool to Creek County Line, a distance of 1.741 miles, be and the same are hereby approved and the Chairman is hereby authorized to sign same. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.
