C O N T R A C T.

THIS CONTRACT AND AGREEMENT, Made and entered into on the 9th. day of July, 1925, by and between Ed W.Hedgecock, W L North and J S Shaver, constituting the Board of County Commissioners of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, hereinafter referred to as First Party and DOLLY BOATRIGT, hereinafter referred to as Second Party.

WITNESSETH: WHEREAS, First Party is informed that there is a large amount of delinquent and unpaid personal taxes due the County of Tulsa, Oklahoma, and its minor political subdivisions, and

WHEREAS, it is the judgment of First Party that it is expedient to collect such delinquent personal taxes, and that it would be to the best interest of Tulsa County to employ a proper person, particularly able to collect such unpaid and delinquent taxes, and to assist the proper officers charged with the duty of collecting such taxes, and such Second Party having hereto performed valuable service in collaborating and compiling information for the purpose of collecting such unpaid and delinquent personal tax, and

WHEREAS, said First Party believing that said Second Party to be the most suitable, efficient and particularly able to render such service and deem such Second Party the proper person to be employed;

NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the services heretofore rendered by said Second party for and on behalf of the First Party, of which services said First Party hereby and herewith accepts, it is mutually agreed by and between said First and Second Party that if said Second Party shall assist the proper officers charged with the duty of collecting its delinquent and unpaid personal tax, and cause said tax to be paid in the manner provided by law, and upon the said Second Party giving Bond in the sum of \$5,000.00 to guarantee the faithful performance of this Contract, first party agrees to pay, or cause to be paid to said Second Party, the product of Fifteen (15%)
