The Chairman declared the meeting open for any business that might properly come beofre it, and the Clerk announced that the petition of H. H. Frencken, H. C. Schutz, J. C. Slater, Joe Wilson, et al, praying for the creation of a drtinage District in Section Twenty Three (23), and parts of Sections Fifteen (15), Twenty Two (22), Twenty Four (24) Twenty five (25), Twenty Six (26) and Twenty Seven (27), all in township Nineteen (19) North, Range Twelve (12) East, in Garden City an addition to the City of Tulsa, Red Fork Township, Tulsa County, Oklahoma, was before the board. The said petition was read before and considered by the Board, and the said board finds that accompanying said petition is a bond signed by H. H. Frencken and H. C. Schutz as principals and Joe Wilson and J. C.
