JULY 13th. 1925.

Pursuant to adjournment, the Board of County Commissioners met in their office with all members present: J S Shaver, Chairman, Ed W. Hedgecock and W L North, Members. O G Weaver, Secretary.

Upon petition of J.N. Williamson and Frank Hackathorne, owners of the property adjacent to Marie Drive, Interurban Addition to the City of Tulsa, on each side of same, it was moved by W L North, seconded by Ed W. Hedgecock, that the same be and is hereby ordered vacated. Motion carried.

The following Resolution was introduced by W L North; who moved its adoption, and the motion to adopt was seconded by Ed W. Hedgecock, and the Chairman ordered the Resolution read:

R E S O L U T I O N.

BE IT RESOLVED, That The County Attorney be and he is hereby directed and instructed to file a mandamus proceeding against James T. Whiteley, County Assessor of Tulsa County for the purpose of requiring him, as the Assessor of said County, to comply with and carry out the orders and directions of the Board of Equalization made on the 16th. and 17th. days of June, 1925, relating to the reduction of real estate valuations in the following named Townships, to-wit:

Boles, Frye and Willow Springs.

The resolution having received the majority of the votes cast was declared carried.

Memorandum of agreement for farm and Home Demonstration work between The County Commissioners of Tulsa County, Oklahoma and The Oklahoma A. & M College, Extension Division in co-operation with The United States Department of Agriculture - States Relation Service.

THIS INSTRUMENT, entered into this the 13th. day of July, 1925 is to witness that the above Commissioners agree to co-operate with the Extension Division of the Oklahoma Agricultural and Mechanical College and the U S Department of Agriculture in conducting Farm and Home Demonstration work in Tulsa County, Oklahoma, during the year 1925-1926, under the following terms:

The County Commissioners agree to pay Two Hundred (\$200.) Dollars per month on the salary of an agent in charge of the Farm Demonstration work for a period of twelve (12) months, beginning July 1st. 1925;

And the County Commissioners agree to pay One Hundred Twenty Dollars (\$120) Per month on the salary of a Home Demonstration Agent for a period of twelve months (12) beginning July 1, 1925;
