Gentlemen:

We, the undersigned, having examined the plans and specifications, the location and character of the work to be done and performed, the character of materials to be used, and the methods to be followed in the laying, curing, etc., and all the other details of construction involved in the laying of concrete construction of curbs, etc., in the work of widening the concrete pavement from Station 0+00 to Sta. 10+00 on the Tulsa-Sand Springs State Highway, respectfully submit to you the following bid:

1958 linear feet of 1:2:3 Concrete pavement, 6 feet wide, 7½" in thickness, aggregating 1305 Square Yards @ Two and 41/100 (\$2.41) Dollars per Square Yard, amounting to the sum of	\$3,145.05

The prices above bid to include all labor, equipment, materials, and each and every detail entering into the construction including barricades, guarding the same during construction and curing, and to construct the work according to the specifications and the instructions of the County Engineer and his duly authorized assistants. We agree to begin the work within 10 days from this date, and to complete all of the said work on or before the first day of May, 1923, or pay to Tulsa County as acknowledged liquidated damages, the sum of \$10.00 per day for each day thereafter that the work remains uncompleted.
