#### R E S O L U T I O N

The Tulsa Board of County Commissioners in regular meeting this the 5th. day of November, 1927, with all three members present, passed the following Resolution:

WHEREAS, the law provides that the County Commissioners may contract with any person, or persons, to assist the proper officers of the County in the discovery, listing and assessing of property not assessed as required by law, and

WHEREAS, the law provides that the Board of County Commissioners may fix the compensation not to exceed fifteen (15%) per cent for such assistance.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That the Board of County Commissioners of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, now in session, that J W RETTIG, of Tulsa County, be and he is hereby employed to aid the proper officers of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, in the discovering, listing and assessing for taxable purposes certain funds and monies which have been heretofore omitted for taxable purposes, and which is now in the hands of Receivers, commonly known as the River Bed Cases now pending in the Federal Court in the Eastern District of Oklahoma.

Said J W RETTIG, being present, before the Board of County Commissioners, accepts said appointment and agrees to perform the services necessary in adding the proper officers of Tulsa County in discovering, listing and assessing taxes against said funds in the hands of such Receivers and his compensation for such services shall be fifteen (15%) per cent of the amount caused to be paid the County Treasurer of said Tulsa County from such discovery.

All monies, checks received on account of such taxes, from said funds, shall be paid to the County Treasurer of Tulsa County, who, in turn is authorized and directed to pay fifteen (15%) per cent of such amount to J W RETTIG for his compensation for such services.
