

TUESDAY, APRIL 18, 1950

Pursuant to recess heretofore taken, the Board of County Commissioners reconvened at the hour of 11:15 o'clock a. m. with all members present: John Couch, Chairman; J. W. Hardesty, Member; and Claude W. Bailey, Member. Andy Stokes, County Clerk.

John Couch, Chairman, presiding, the following business was transacted:

Motion made by Commissioner Couch, seconded by Commissioner Bailey, and unanimously carried, that upon the recommendation of the County Attorney's office and Holly Anderson, Attorney, for Tulsa County Drainage District No. 12, that claim #10001 against Tulsa County Drainage District No. 12 in the amount of \$16,047.65 filed by the Sinclair Refining Company, be allowed in the amount of \$3200.00, which amount the Sinclair Refining Company, by its attorney, Mr. I. L. Lockowitz, in open session, agreed to accept in full settlement of said claim.

Motion made by Commissioner Hardesty, seconded by Commissioner Bailey, that the County Attorney be authorized to effect an Appeal in the case of Roy J. David vs. Tulsa County Drainage District No. 12 and the Board of County Commissioners of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, pending in the State Industrial Commission, and that the County Attorney be authorized to procure necessary bond and to file a claim for the necessary filing fees on the Appeal. Upon roll call motion unanimously carried.

Motion made by Commissioner Hardesty, seconded by Commissioner Couch, and unanimously carried, that the following Deputies in the office of the Court Clerk be given an increase in salaries as follows: Paul Brightmire, Minute Clerk Div. 1, \$25.00; Ed C. McCarty, Receptionist Clerk, District Court, \$10.00 per month and Irma Meredith, Deputy, County Court, \$15.00 per month.
