WITNESSETH: That the parties of the first part do hereby employ party of the second part to assist the proper officers of said County in the discovery of all property not listed or assessed for taxes that has ben omitted from the regular tax rolls for the years 1925 and 1926, and any years where property subject to taxation under the existing tax laws of the State of Oklahoma, the same to be duly assessed and taxes therefrom collected as provided by Section 9798 of the 1921 Compiled Statutes of Oklahoma.

IT IS HEREBY AGREED That the said County shall not be liable for any court costs or expense of litigation; and that as a compensation for said services party of the first part agrees that party of the second part shallreceive fifteen per cent of all taxes so collected, no part of which is to be paid party of the second part until same is collected and in the hands of the County Treasurer of Tulsa County, Oklahoma.

IT IS FURTHER AGREED AND UNDERSTOOD that party of the second part shall not begin operation nor assess omitted property for 1925 and 1926 until the regular assessment for each of the named years shall be completed and equalized.

IT IS FURTHER AGREED AND UNDERSTOOD that this contract may be terminated at any time at the discretion of the party of the first part.
