

WEDNESDAY, JULY 2nd, 1941.

Motion by Commissioner Sallee, seconded by Commissioner Morley, that a duplicate county deed be issued to Rahe L. Oldham covering Lot 19, Block 11, Greenwood Addition to Tulsa, for the reason that said deed was lost and never received by the purchaser, according to an affidavit made by Mr. Oldham, and the Chairman is hereby authorized to execute said deed.
