R E S O L U T I O N

After due and careful consideration of the statements contained in the application of Joe T. Parkinson, County Treasurer of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, for authority to purchase \$4,000.00 of Tulsa County Free Fair Bonds of 1931 as investments for the County sinking fund of said county; and

WHEREAS, it is deemed to the best interest of said Tulsa County and to the Sinking Fund thereof that said purchase be made at the prices and under the terms and conditions set out in the application of the Treasurer of said County to this Board of County Commissioners.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF TULSA COUNTY, STATE OF OKLAHOMA

Section 1.

That the County Treasurer of said Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma, be and he is hereby authorized to purchase the securities described in his application to this Board, at the prices therein set out and that his actions in so doing are hereby ratified and confirmed.

Section 2.

That the County Treasurer of said Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma, shall, in addition to this resolution, receive the necessary approval by the District Court of said Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma, as provided by law.
