John Craig Cartmill and Rahe L. Oldham appearing in person in behalf of their petition to vacate road, it is moved by Commissioner Couch, seconded by Commissioner Bailey, and unanimously carried, that the following Order be entered and spread of record:

ORDER OF BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS  
VACATING ROAD LYING IN  $S\frac{1}{2}$   $SW\frac{1}{4}$   $NW\frac{1}{4}$   $SE\frac{1}{4}$ ,  
Sec. 17, Twp. 19 N., Rge 13 E., Tulsa  
County, Oklahoma

The petition to vacate and set aside certain portion of dedication of road, recorded in Book 1743, at page 265, in the office of the County Clerk of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, insofar as said dedication covers lands hereinafter more particularly described, heretofore filed with the County Clerk of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, signed by twelve freeholders residing in the vicinity of the road affected, now pending before the Board of County Commissioners of said County, coming on for hearing on this 30th day of April, 1948, at 10 o'clock a.m., in the Office of the County Clerk of Tulsa County, in the County Court House, in Tulsa, Tulsa County, Oklahoma, pursuant to order of said Board of County Commissioners setting said petition for hearing and action thereon at 10 a.m., on April 26, 1948, and pursuant to further order continuing this matter to this time, place and hour, said petitioners appearing by their attorney, Lamoin Oldham, and in person as follows: Rahe L. Oldham, and John Craig Cartmill and, thereupon, no protests or objections to the granting of said petition to vacate said road having been filed with the County Clerk of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, or having been presented to said hearing before said County Commissioners of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, said Board, upon an examination of said petition to vacate and subsequent filings in connection therewith, and upon the examination of witnesses sworn and examined before said Board, finds: That all of the allegations of said petition to vacate certain portions of said county road, as more particularly hereinafter described, are true; that heretofore and on March 25, 1948, twelve freeholders residing in the vicinity of the road affected, signed and filed with the County Clerk of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, said petition to vacate together with a bond executed by one of said petitioners, payable to the County of Tulsa, conditioned to pay costs of said proceeding if petition be not granted; and, that due legal notice to the public for twenty (20) days by advertisement in the Tulsa Daily Legal News, the official County paper, was given, setting forth the facts and the date, hour and place when and where hearing would be held and petition acted upon, as shown by proof of publication heretofore filed with the County Clerk of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, and at said time, place and hour when this matter was originally set for hearing, due and legal public notice was given of the aforesaid order continuing said hearing to this time, place and hour; that the owner through whose land the road proposed to be vacated goes is one of the aforesaid petitioners and has heretofore filed with said County Clerk of Tulsa County request that said petition be granted, and said proceedings to vacate are in all particulars complete; that said land so dedicated and for which vacation is sought, has never been used by the public as a road or highway and a road thereon is unnecessary and impractical, and said land is outside the city limits of the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma, and has never been platted and is not a part of any plat or addition to said City; and said Board further finds that the aforesaid dedication recorded in Book 1743, at page 265, in the office of the County Clerk of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, insofar as such dedication covers land hereinafter described, should be vacated and set aside,

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma, that said dedication of road made on the 26th day of August, 1946, by Chas. D. Thomas and John Craig Cartmill, by deed of dedication recorded in Book 1743, at page 265, in the office of the County Clerk of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, insofar as said dedication covers lands lying in the South Half ( $S\frac{1}{2}$ ) of the Southwest Quarter ( $SW\frac{1}{4}$ ) of the Northwest Quarter ( $NW\frac{1}{4}$ ) of the Southeast Quarter ( $SE\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section Seventeen (17), Township Nineteen (19) North, Range Thirteen (13) East, Tulsa County, Oklahoma, be, and the same hereby is, vacated and set aside, and that all right, title and interest conveyed, granted or vested by, through or under said deed of dedication, insofar as same is hereby vacated, be, and the same hereby is transferred, granted and revested in the owner of the lands through which said road so vacated goes.
