RESOLUTION VACATING KERR STREET IN POMERCY HEIGHTS ADDITION TO THE CITY OF TULSA, OKLAHOMA.

WHEREAS, Kerr Street in Pomeroy Heights Addition to the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma, is not within the corporate limits of the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma, or of any incorporated village or town, but is a part of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, and within the jurisdiction of the Board of County Commissioners of Tulsa County and the dedication thereof has never been accepted by the Board of County Commissioners of Tulsa County, Oklahoma; and

WHEREAS, said Kerr Street in Pomeroy Heights Addition to the City of Tulsa Oklahoma, is a short street running one block North from Admiral Drive, and is the heatural schanneluforing water course draining said Pomeroy Heights Addition, and is not an open street, and can never be opened except at a great expense; and

WHEREAS, the owners of the property adjoining said Kerr Street have entered into a contract agreeing to the vacation of said street;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, By the Board off County Commissioners of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, that Kerr Street in Pomercy Heights Addition to the City ofmTulsa, Tulsa County Oklahoma, according to the recorded plat thereof, running North from Federal Drive, be and the same is vacated, and that the contract hereinabove referred to, as the same appears of record in the office of the County Clerk of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, is by reference made a part hereof.
