At a meeting of the Board of County Commissioners of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, held on the 13th day of July, 1935, and at which meeting all members were present, the following Resolution was introduced by Commissioner Gray, who moved its adoption; said motion being seconded by Commissioner Hopkins. Chairman ordered the Resolution read.

R E S O L U T I O N

WHEREAS, in the fiscal year 1934-35 an appropriation was made for an audit to be performed by the State Examiner and Inspector, and

WHEREAS, on June 30th, 1935, there was an unexpended and unencumbered balance of \$813.88, and

WHEREAS, the said State Examiner and Inspector's force are now working on said audit in this current month, July, 1935, and

WHEREAS, no estimate of needs was requested by this Board for an audit for the fiscal year ending June 30th, 1936.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that this Board do and hereby request the Tulsa County Excise Board to appropriate the said surplus of \$813.88 for the payment of salaries and legal expenses incurred by the State Examiner and Inspector's staff for the month of July, 1935.

The motion having carried, the Resolution was declared adopted and ordered into the County Commissioners' proceedings and a certified copy delivered to the Tulsa County Excise Board.

Motion by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner Hopkins, that ^{W.J.} "Bill" Cordroy be and he is hereby appointed Drainage Ditch Commissioner for Parkview Drainage District. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion/^{was} ~~by~~ by the Chairman declared carried.

There being nothing further to come before the Board, a recess is hereby taken until Monday, July 15th, 1935, at the hour of 10:00 o'clock A.M.
